SUBJECT: ACTIVITIES AND CHARGES SUBJECT TO ECONOMIC REGULATION. CHARGES CONSULTATION PROCESS 2016.

BASICS DOCUMENTS: DMS no. 564406 of 30.10.2015 and attached documents

DISCLOSURE:

In the terms of decree-law 254/2012, published on November 28th, changed by decree-law 108/2013 published on July 31th and of the Concession Contracts for the airport public service established with the Portuguese Government, ANA Aeroportos de Portugal SA (ANA) is the Concessionaire of national airports in Portugal's mainland (Lisbon, Porto, Faro and Beja), in the Azorean Autonomous Region (Ponta Delgada, Santa Maria, Horta and Flores) and of the regional airports of the Madeira Autonomous Region (Madeira and Porto Santo).

With the stated objective of setting January 1st 2016 as the date for effect of the 2016 charges applicable to activities subject to economic regulation, on August 1st 2015, ANA formally launched the consultation process for the Users of the Lisbon Group airports (Lisbon, Beja, Ponta Delgada, Santa Maria, Horta, Flores, Madeira e Porto Santo), Porto airport and Faro airport.

The consultation procedure began more than 120 days before the new regulated charges come into effect, thus meeting the legally established deadline.

The airports' users, its representatives or associations were consulted and the Autonomous Regions of the Azores and Madeira were heard under the terms and for the purposes of articles 72 and 79 of Decree Law no. 254/2012.

In order to simplify the process and to allow an integrated and global understanding of the adjustments in the regulated charges system for 2016, ANA, just as in the Consultation Process of 2015, combined into a single procedure three distinct charges consultations applicable in 2016, regarding traffic and ground handling assistance activities subject to economic regulation, as well as security activities that generate revenue for the Concessionaire and the assistance to Passengers with Reduced Mobility (PRM).

Regarding the consultation process for 2016 security charges, now concluded, we are awaiting for the governmental decision and publication, in the terms and for the effects mentioned on n. 2 of article 52 of decree-law n. 254/2012.

As for the Consultation for the Charges of PRM assistance for 2016, also concluded, we are awaiting the approval of the Board of the National Civil Aviation Authority (ANAC), in the terms of n. 3 of article 61 of decree-law 254/2012.

Closing the consultation process for 2016 charges applicable to the activities of traffic and ground handling that are subject to economic regulation, under the terms of Decree Law no. 254/2012 and of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract, it is important to consider that:

- a. The charges proposals presented were formulated in strict compliance with the terms and limits established in Annex 12 of the Concession Contract for the RRC₁₆ of the airports in the Lisbon Group, Porto airport and Faro airport, confirming the amounts proposed for the security and assistance to passengers with reduced mobility (PRM) charges.
- b. With the publication of the actual HIPC (27 countries of the European Union) reported in August 2015, at 0.1%, instead of the 0.2% estimate initially presented, ANA, as expressly stated in the consultation process, recalculated the regulated revenue cap for each of the airports in the network, and the value of each of the regulated charges, maintaining all the previously estimated modulations and the methodology defined in Annex 12 of the Concession Contract. The details of the recalculation of the adjusted regulated charges after applying the actual HIPC (27 countries of the European Union), reported in August 2015, at 0.1% are mentioned and integrated on this Decision annex 1.
- **c.** ANA charges proposal adjusted by applying the HIPC reported in August 2015 at 0,1%, are stated in the Table of charges subject to economic regulation, integrated on this Decision- annex II.
- **d.** The variation in the set of ANA's regulated charges represents in annual terms an average increase of 2,82%, with the following distribution across ANA airports:
 - Lisbon: 4,44%
 - Azores: 0,73%
 - Madeira: -1,02%
 - Porto: 1,41%
 - Faro: 0,89%
 - Beja: 0,00%





- e. In absolute terms, the increase in regulated revenue per terminal passenger is €0.27 in ANA network, with the following distribution across the airports:
 - Lisbon: €0.46
 - Azores: -€0.05
 - Madeira:- €0.12
 - Porto: €0.11
 - Faro: €0.07
 - Beja: €0,00
- f. The absolute evolutions proposed do not constitute an excessive adjustment of charges, nor do they compromise the activities developed at ANA airports, even including charges reduction for Madeira Airports.
- **g.** In terms of modulation of the charges structure, the measures proposed by ANA aim, essentially at Lisbon Airport, to promote efficiency and rationalization/optimisation of the capacity of airside infrastructures, namely parking stands and on the terminal, the check-in counters. The measures aim, as well, the strengthening of the competitive positioning of the Lisbon hub by means of increasing competitiveness in the transfer passenger segment and also by fighting Faro airport seasonality in the IATA winter season.
- **h.** The RRC₂₀₁₆ published by ANA for the airports of the Lisbon Group, Porto airport and Faro airport have to be based on a traffic forecast for 2016, so, inevitably, they assume a provisional nature, thus being susceptible to possible adjustment regarding the actual traffic in 2016. The adjustment will determine, in the event of lower traffic than initially forecasted, a refund by ANA of the difference resulting from the error in the forecast of the number of terminal passengers, or, on the other hand, in the event of higher traffic than initially forecasted, to adjustments provided for in no. 5 of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract.
- **i.** All the reports received within the legal deadline from the consulted users, their representatives or associations as well as from the Azorean and Madeira Autonomous Regions, were carefully





evaluated. ANA has sent its comments to the Regulatory Authority and to all consulted users and entities, complying to what is stated in no 4 of article 71 of decree law no 254/2012.

Within this framework, it was decided, pursuant to line b) of no. 7 of article 7 and n. 4 of article 71, both from decree-law n. 254/2012 and under the terms and on the legal and economic grounds stated in the basic documents that are an integrating part of this Decision:

- 1. To maintain the charges proposals presented by ANA for the airports of the Lisbon Group, Porto airport and Faro airport, duly reviewed according to the variation of the value of the HIPC published by Eurostat reported in August 2015 for the value initially indicated in the charges consultation process launched in August 1st 2015.
- **2.** To approve the ANA charges proposal for the charges subject to economic regulation to be applied in 2016, effective from 1 January 2016, assumed in the Table of Regulated Charges Annex II of this Decision.

This Decision is taken waiving a hearing of interested parties, pursuant of lines d) and e) of article 124 of the Administrative Procedural Code approved by decree-law n. 4/2015, of January 7, considering the charges consultation process for 2016 and the level of participation of the Users, their representatives or associations in the process, as well as the Azores and Madeira Autonomous Regions:

As required on n. 5 of article 71 of decree-law 254/2012, this Decision will be published in ANA's website, along with the approved Table of Charges for 2016 – annex II.
