#### DECISION

SUBJECT: ACTIVITIES AND CHARGES SUBJECT TO ECONOMIC REGULATION. 2018 CHARGES CONSULTATION PROCESS.

**BASIC DOCUMENTS**: DMS n. 611234 of 31-10-2017 Revision of the Regulated Revenue Cap for 2018, by application of the actual H ICP (28 countries of the European Union), reported for August 2017

2018 Consultation Process for Regulated Charges

DISCLOSURE: ANA's website

Under the terms of Decree-Law 254/2012, published on 28<sup>th</sup> November, changed by Decree-Law 108/2013 published on 31<sup>st</sup> July, and of the Concession Contracts for the airport public service established with the Portuguese Government, ANA Aeroportos de Portugal SA (ANA) is the Concessionaire of national airports in Portugal's mainland (Lisbon, Porto, Faro and Beja), in the Azorean Autonomous Region (Ponta Delgada, Santa Maria, Horta and Flores) and in the regional airports of the Madeira Autonomous Region (Madeira and Porto Santo).

With the stated objective of setting 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 as the date for entry into effect of the 2018 charges applicable to airport activities subject to economic regulation, ANA formally launched, on 4<sup>th</sup> August 2017, the corresponding consultation process for the Users of the Lisbon Group airports (Lisbon, Beja, Ponta Delgada, Santa Maria, Horta, Flores, Madeira and Porto Santo), Porto airport and Faro airport.

The consultation procedure began more than 120 days before the new regulated charges come into effect, thus meeting the legally established deadline.

The users of the above mentioned airports, their representatives or associations were consulted and the Autonomous Regions of the Azores and Madeira were also heard, under the terms and for the purposes of Articles 71 and 79 of Decree-Law 254/2012.





In order to simplify the process and with the aim of greater transparency and an integrated and global understanding of the adjustments for 2018 in the regulated charges system, and continuing the procedure adopted in the charges consultation processes already carried out, ANA combined into a single procedure three distinct charges consultations applicable in 2018, regarding traffic and ground handling assistance activities subject to economic regulation, as well as security activities that generate revenue for the Concessionaire and the activity of assistance to Passengers with Reduced Mobility (PRM).

Regarding the consultation process for 2018 security charges, now concluded, the relevant governmental decision and governmental publication is awaited, in the terms and for the effects mentioned on n. 2 of Article 52 of Decree-Law 254/2012. The approval of the PRM charge by the Board of the national Civil Aviation Authority (ANAC), in the terms of n. 3 of Article 61 of Decree-Law 254/2012 is also being awaited.

In finalizing the consultation process for 2018 charges applicable to the activities of traffic and ground handling that are subject to economic regulation under the terms of Decree-Law 254/2012 and of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract, it is important to consider that:

- a. With the publication of the actual HICP (28 countries of the European Union), reported in August 2017, at 1.4%, instead of the 1.5% initially mentioned in the consultation process, ANA, maintaining all the previously modulations proposed and the methodology defined in Annex 12 of the Concession Contract, recalculated the regulated revenue cap (RRC) for each of the airports in the network, the details of which are mentioned in the attached document (Annex I);
- b. As a result, the charges proposal for the Porto, Faro and Azores airports were adjusted by applying the HICP reported in August 2017 of 1.4%. On the other hand, the charges proposal for the Lisbon airport did not undergo any adjustment because it was below the RRC<sub>18</sub> established for the Lisbon Group. This situation also happened with Madeira and Beja because the charges for these airports remain the same as the ones published in 2017.
- c. ANA reviews its charge proposal for passenger assistance self-service baggage drop-off at Lisbon airport, so that this charge can be applied to monthly rentals or periods of 15 minutes, keeping the same values of traditional check-in desks. This review resulted from comments received from clients during the consultation process;
- d. The adjustment in the set of ANA's regulated charges represents, in annual terms, an average increase of 1.97%, with the following distribution across the airports of the network:
  - Lisbon: 1.94%
  - Azores: 1.18%





- Madeira: 0.00%
- Porto: 2.19%
- Faro: 3.10%
- Beja: 0.00%
- e. In absolute terms, the increase in regulated revenue per terminal passenger is €0.19 in the ANA network, with the following distribution across the airports:
  - Lisbon: €0.18
  - Azores: €0.08
  - Madeira: €0.00
  - Porto: €0.17
  - Faro: € 0.25
  - Beja: €0.00
- f. The absolute evolutions proposed do not constitute an excessive adjustment of charges, nor do they compromise the activities developed at ANA airports or the corresponding competitiveness of the charges;
- g. In terms of the tariff structure, the actions proposed by ANA aim, essentially:
  - At Lisbon airport to promote the increase of efficiency and rationalization / optimization of the capacity of its infrastructures in the air side, by the increase of the tonnage to apply the minimum value per landing operation and the amount to apply to parking periods between 12 and 24 hours;
  - At Porto airport to continue the process of convergence of the Non-Schengen and International passenger segment and the charge differentiation of passengers in transfer;
  - At Faro airport and at Porto Santo Airport, to combat the seasonality that affects these airports during the winter season and also to promote the use of telescopic bridges at Faro airport.
- h. The RRC<sub>2018</sub> published for the airports of the Lisbon Group, as well as for the Porto airport and the Faro airport have to be based on a traffic forecast for 2018, so that they are inevitably of a provisional nature, and, thus, susceptible to possible adjustment given the actual traffic in 2018. In the event of higher traffic than initially forecasted, the adjustments provided in n. 5 of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract will take place;
- i. The reports submitted by Users, their representatives or associations, as well by the Autonomous Region of Madeira were carefully evaluated. ANA sent the corresponding comments to all the Users and other consulted entities, as well as to the Regulating Authority, fully complying with that established in n. 4 of Article 71 of Decree-Law 254/2012.





Within this framework, it was decided, pursuant to line b) of n. 1 of Article 7 and n. 4 of Article 71, both from Decree-Law 254/2012 and under the terms and on the legal and economic grounds stated in the documents that are an integrating part of this Decision, waiving a hearing of interested parties, pursuant of lines d) and e) of Article 124 of the Administrative Procedural Code (APC) approved by Decree-Law 4/2015, of 7th January, considering the charges consultation process for 2018 and the level of involvement of the Users, their representatives or associations in the process, as well as the Azores and Madeira Autonomous Regions:

- To approve the ANA charges proposal for the charges subject to economic regulation to be applied in 2018, assumed in the Table of Regulated Charges that make up Annex II of this Decision, which will be effective as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018. Keep the tariff proposals submitted by ANA for Lisbon airport, which is below RRC<sub>2018</sub>, and for Madeira airport and Beja Civil Terminal, as they remain identical to the rates in force in 2017;
- 2) To approve for Porto Airport, Faro Airport and the Azores airports, keep the proposals but with a downward revision due to the value of the HICP published by Eurostat reported in August 2017 compared to the value initially indicated in the tariff consultation process released on August 4, 2017;
- Review the proposal presented for the passenger assistance rate self-service drop-off of checked baggage, so that it is applied to monthly rentals or to periods of 15 minutes, having in consideration the Users' contributions in this matter;

Furthermore, it is decided that:

- i) The 2018 Regulated Charges Consultation Process file Annex III of this Decision will be sent to all Users that participated in the Consultation Process, as well as to ANAC, thus complying with what is stated in n. 4 of Article 71 of Decree-Law 254/2012; and
- ii) This Decision will be publish in ANA's website by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017, along with the approved Table of Charges
   Annex II of this Decision as required in n. 5 of Article 71 of Decree-Law 254/2012.

The amount of the Regulated Revenue Cap (RRC) shall be increased by 7.363.424€ [7.119.372\*(1+2,0%)\*(1+1,4%)], in order to recover the deviation due to forecasting errors that occurred in 2016 under the terms of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract.

Considering that the miscalculation adjustment of the forecast for 2016, to be recovered in 2018, is higher than the amount of that same adjustment for 2015, recovered in 2017, ANA maintains its proposal to increase the landing charge for 2018 (keeping the value regarding the additional the same that was applied in 2017).

The RRC shall be applied at the various Lisbon Group airports in accordance with the amounts set in the following table, as a result of applying the constraints established under the terms of the Concession Contract for the Madeira airports and the proposal regarding traffic and ground handling assistance charges adjusted by applying the HICP for the Azores airports.

## **1.1 LISBON AIRPORT**

### An overall increase in annual regulated charges of 1.94%.

Since the charges proposal presented by ANA for the Lisbon Airport is based on an average evolution in regulated charges of 1.94% - clearly below the average evolution authorized for regulated charges at this airport, which is 11.65% - this charges proposal was not subject to a revision applying the actual HICP reported for August 2017.
