



# **Regulated Revenue Cap**

**Regulated Revenues and Terminal Passengers 2020** 





According to the applicable law, ANA, Airports of Portugal, SA, hereinafter referred to as ANA, presents this report in order to allow the monitoring of the regulated charges revenues and terminal passengers at the airports of ANA network in 2020, under the new economic regulation regime, established by Decree-Law 254/2012 of 28 November with the wording of Decree-law 108/2013 of 31 July, and by the Concession Contracts concluded between the Portuguese State and ANA.

The publication of this information will take place in ANA's electronic web page, ensuring that the Regulatory Authority, Airlines and other stakeholders can exercise their right to monitor the fulfilment of the obligations established in Annex 12 of the Concession Contract.

This document is meant to present the financial and operational information regarding the year 2020, including the description of the revenue obtained with the application of regulated charges and the number of terminal passengers<sup>1</sup> registered in 2020 at the airports of ANA network.

The mix deviation component of miscalculation adjustment of Lisbon Group, was determined considering two different methodologies:

- The value of the Regulated Revenue Cap, determined in accordance with point 4.3 and the formula in figure 2- Methodology for Calculating the Maximum Average Revenue 2014-2022, of Annex 12 of the CC. This methodology has always been applied by ANA.
- 2. The value of the Regulated Revenue per terminal passenger estimated by ANA and published on October 8, 2019 in the consultation document of 2020 charges proposal as determined by ANAC. ANA doesn't follow ANAC's understanding and determination, reserving the right to use available means, including judicial, to defend its interests and rights.

The information presented was the subject of an examination by Deloitte & Associados, SROC S.A., under the terms of, and in compliance with, the provisions of point 10.1 of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract, and their report is attached.

The Regulated Revenue (RR) is equal to the quotient between the total revenue of the activities and services referred to in Appendix A of Annex 12 and the number of terminal passengers in each of the airports or group of airports identified in Annex 12 (2) of the Concession Contract (CC), i.e.

• Lisbon Group (including Lisbon, Ponta Delgada, Santa Maria, Horta, Flores, Madeira and Porto Santo Airports and the Civil Terminal of Beja)

- Porto Airport
- Faro Airport

The revenues considered for the establishment of the RR of each Airport or group of airports arise from the regulated charges applied according to the applicable legislation (Decree-Law 254/2012) and to the Concession Contract (Annex 12):

- Traffic (articles 26 to 30 of DL 254/2012 and Appendix A of Annex 12 of the CC)
  - Landing and Take-off
  - Aircraft parking (including airbridges and GPS)
  - Hangar
  - Passenger service
  - Aerodrome opening
- Ground handling (article 32 (b) and (c) of DL 254/2012 and Appendix A of Annex 12 of the CC):
  - Passenger handling
  - Baggage handling
- Security Charge (Chapter IV, Articles 48 to 56 of DL 254/2012)
- Service charge to PRM (Chapter V, Articles 57 to 64, DL 254/2012)
- CUPPS, CUSS and BRS charge (does not include consumables) (Appendix A of Annex 12 of the CC)

The revenues arising from flights operated by pure freight flights are excluded from the revenues used for the calculation of the Regulated Revenue (RR), as established in Annex 12 (2.6) of the Concession Contract.

### 1. MISCALCULATION ADJUSTMENT 2020 - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

It is presented below an indicative table of the amounts to be considered as miscalculation adjustment according to the methodology followed by ANA

ANAC determined the application of a different methodology for calculating the adjustment for errors of estimate in 2019 2for the Lisbon Group, a position that ANA doesn't follow, reserving the recourse to the available means, including judicial, to defend its rights and interests.

If ANAC keeps its position about the miscalculation adjustment calculation, the following table values are the result from the application of the methodology determined by ANAC, nevertheless ANA has the right to challenge such understanding.

Considering the 70% refund of Landing, passenger and baggage assistance charges, carried out between July and December of 2020, as well as the miscalculation adjustments of 2020 presented in this report, the total amount means a global "discount" at 2020 Regulated Charges of:

- ANA's methodology : -26<sup>2</sup>%
- Methodology determined by ANAC: -30<sup>3</sup>%

Porto Airport: -18<sup>4</sup>%

Faro Airport: -45<sup>5</sup>%

### 2. TERMINAL PASSENGERS 2020

Terminal Passengers are calculated according to the listed traffic data recorded. This data is registered in the traffic statistic reporting system "Business Intelligence", which is used at ANA and has historical data available since the year 2000.

Traffic data gathered in ANA airports derives from mandatory traffic forms (national document of ANAC) for each aircraft movement, filled in by the ground handling agents or Airlines in each of the national airports. This data is the basis for invoice procedures and traffic information.

In 2020, Terminal Passengers in Lisbon Group totalled 11,301,407 according to the following distribution in the different airports:

In 2020, at Porto Airport, 4,417,662 Terminal Passengers were registered, while at Faro Airport, up to 2,185,231 Terminal Passengers were recorded.

### **3. FINANCIAL INFORMATION - REVENUE**

The financial information presented in this document is based on the data registered in the Accounting Software of the company, the SAP R3, as a result of the invoices and release notes issued by the invoicing system, regarding the activity in 2020.

In 2020, the revenue obtained through the regulated charges, at ANA airports, totalled € 187,027,598.

In 2020, the revenue obtained through the regulated charges in Lisbon Group were up to  $\leq 133,881,139 \in$ whereas terminal passengers totalled 11,301,407. Due to the application of traffic risk sharing the 2018 error estimation recovery hasn't been considered in 2020 Regulated Revenues. The Regulated Revenue per terminal passenger resulted in  $\leq 11,85$ . The following table presents the revenue, per regulated charge in 2020, for the airports included in the Lisbon Group.

Revenue obtained through regulated charges at Porto Airport, in 2020, totalled  $\leq$ 35,673,431. The terminal passengers registered were 4,417,662 and after considering the deduction of 2018 Miscalculation Adjustment, leads to a regulated charge revenue of  $\leq$ 8.80 per terminal passenger, as presented in the following table:

Revenue obtained through regulated charges at Faro Airport, in 2020, amounted to €17,473,028, while the terminal passengers were 2,185,231 which results, in a regulated charge revenue of €8,00 per terminal passenger.

As in Porto Airport, there is no recovery of 2018 miscalculation adjustment for Faro Airport.



### 4. CALCULATION OF THE "FORECAST ERRORS ADJUSTMENTS"

According to Annex 12 (5) of the Concession Contract, there are two types of adjustments arising from forecast errors: the forecast error related to the annual passenger traffic volume with impact on the calculation of the Airside Retail Contribution (CRLA) per terminal passenger (PT) and the forecast error related to the traffic mix and /or the composition of the available services and activities.

Taking into account the number of terminal passengers and the actual revenues that stemmed from the application of the regulated charges, subsequent adjustments, due to forecast errors, were calculated for Lisbon Group, Porto Airport and Faro Airport, according to the following calculation formulas:

### a) Adjustment due to forecast error related to traffic volume

The difference between the actual number of terminal passengers registered in 2020 and the number of terminal passengers forecasted in the charges proposal determines a variation of the ARC per terminal passenger and, therefore, of the Regulated Revenue Cap authorized for 2020 (RRCap<sub>2020</sub>). The adjustment amount is computed as the deviations of the RRCap<sub>2020</sub> times the actual number of terminal passengers attended during 2020:

[(ARC 2020 /PT proposal 2020) – (ARC 2020 /actual PT2020)] = Δ authorized RRCap2020

# b) Adjustment due to forecast error related to the traffic mix and /or the composition of the available services and activities

Due to the effect of variations registered in the traffic mix and in the demand profile, both of which have an impact in the configuration of the services and lead to changes in the regulated revenue per terminal passenger, a deviation was determined in the Actual Regulated Revenue obtained in 2020 (Actual RR<sub>2020</sub>) compared to the authorised revenue of the same year (RRCap<sub>2020</sub>).

In total, the adjustments due to forecast errors regarding the year 2020 have been the following:

### **Lisbon Group Airports:**

ANA's Methodology (in accordance with point 4.3 and the formula in figure 2- Methodology for Calculating the Maximum Average Revenue 2014-2022, of Annex 12 of the CC): € -26,106,250.

ANAC's Methodology: €-33,226,137

Porto Airport : €-3,489,953

Faro Airport: €-6.359.022

The negative deviations calculated for Lisbon Group, Porto and Faro airports have as a consequence an excess of revenue charged, which will be returned to the clients by the end of June 2021, in the same proportion as the revenues from regulated activities obtained in 2020 in each of those airports, as established in line a) of point 5.1 of Annex 12 of the Concession Contract.

Taking into account the existing dispute between ANA,SA and ANAC regarding the methodology for calculating the miscalculation adjustment at Lisbon Group, ANA is going to return to Users the amount



of € 26,106,250, until the end of June 2021, following the methodology advocated by ANA SA, this is as a result from the application of the Authorized RR Cap in 2020.

If ANAC keeps for 2020 its interpretation about the calculation of the Miscalculation adjustment that followed in 2019, imposing to ANA the reimbursement of  $\notin$  33,226,137, ANA will comply with such instruction without prejudice its right to take a legal action against it.
